

RESOLUTION NO. 2025 - 62

OF THE BEXAR COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT #10 ("DISTRICT") BOARD OF DIRECTORS ("BOARD") APPROVING AN INCREASE OF THE MONTHLY SERVICE AVAILABILITY FEES BEING PART OF THE DISTRICT'S WATER SERVICE RATES FROM (1)) \$19.87 TO \$21.85 (FOR A 5/8" & 3/4" METER), \$27.93 TO \$29.91 (FOR A 1" METER), \$47.06 TO \$49.04 (FOR A 1 1/2" METER), AND \$69.24 TO \$71.22 (FOR A 2" METER) FOR RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER ACCOUNTS EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 28, 2026; AND (2) \$26.22 TO \$28.20 (FOR A 5/8" & 3/4" METER), \$45.81 TO \$47.79 (FOR A 1" METER), \$75.72 TO 77.70 (FOR A 1 1/2" METER), \$111.43 TO \$113.41 (FOR A 2" METER) AND \$166.40 TO \$168.38 (FOR A 3" METER) FOR COMMERCIAL CUSTOMER ACCOUNTS EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 28, 2026; FINDING THE RESOLUTION TO HAVE BEEN CONSIDERED PURSUANT TO THE LAWS GOVERNING OPEN MEETINGS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 51.338 of the Texas Water Code, the Bexar County Water Control and Improvement District #10's ("District") Board of Directors ("Board") have the right to adopt water charges; and

WHEREAS, the District owns and operates its own water system within its service area as authorized by Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 20287; and

WHEREAS, the District's revenue requirements necessitate that its monthly service availability fees being a part of the water service rates be increased to recover its costs of service and related debt service and reserve fund coverage requirements; and

WHEREAS, the District's Board desires to increase the District's monthly service availability fees being a part of the District's water service rates to recover its costs of service and related debt service and reserve fund coverage requirements; now, therefore:

WHEREAS, the District has determined it is in the best interest of the District's ratepayers to increase the monthly service availability fees being part of the District's water service rates; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE DISTRICT'S BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

1. That the revised monthly service availability fees being a part of the District's water service rates of (a) \$19.87 To \$21.85 (For A 5/8" & 3/4" Meter), \$27.93 To \$29.91 (For A 1" Meter), \$47.06 To \$49.04 (For A 1 1/2" Meter), And \$69.24 To \$71.22 (For A 2" Meter) For Residential Customer Accounts Effective February 28, 2026; And (2) \$26.22 To \$28.20 (For A 5/8" & 3/4" Meter), \$45.81 To \$47.79 (For A 1" Meter), \$75.72 To 77.70 (For A 1 1/2" Meter), \$111.43 To \$113.41 (for A 2" Meter) And \$166.40 To \$168.38 (For A 3" Meter) For Commercial Customer Accounts Effective February 28, 2026.


2. That the District's current monthly service availability fees being a part of the District's water service rates of (a) \$19.87 (for a 5/8" & 3/4" Meter), \$27.93 (for a 1" Meter), \$47.06 (for a 1 1/2" Meter), and \$69.24 (for a 2" Meter) for residential customer accounts; and (b) \$26.22 (for a 5/8" & 3/4" Meter), \$45.81 (for a 1" Meter), \$75.72 (for a 1 1/2" Meter), \$111.43 (for a 2" Meter) and \$166.40 (for a 3" Meter) for commercial customer accounts shall no longer be assessed to any District water service customer upon the implementation of the new fees in Section 1 herein.

3. It is officially found, determined and declared that the meeting at which this Resolution is adopted was open to the public, and that public notice of the time, place, and subject matter of the public business to be conducted at such meeting, including this Resolution, was given to all as required by the Texas Codes Annotated, as amended, Title 5, Chapter 551, Government Code.



If any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, or word of this Resolution is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, illegal, inoperative, invalid or ineffective, or if any exception to or limitation upon any general provision herein contained is held to be unconstitutional, illegal, inoperative, invalid or ineffective, the remainder of this Resolution shall nevertheless stand effective and valid as if it had been enacted without the portion held to be unconstitutional, illegal, inoperative, invalid or ineffective.
